

In the Name of God Amen) the 15th day of January 1838. I Mary H. Swann of the District of York & State of South Carolina. Being of sound mind and memory and calling to mind the mortality of my Body, and knowing that it is appointed for all once to die, do make and ordain this my last will and testament. Concerning such worldly Estate as God in his mercy hath been pleased to bless me with. I give and bequeath the same in manner and form following. In the first place I give my Body to the dust and my soul to God who gave it. In the Second plan I give and bequeath to my two sons, viz, Joseph Addison and Edward Eaton, both their living of a tract of Land will'd to me by my father containing 100 acres less or more In the District and State aforesaid bounded as follows, beginning at a post oak near Charleston road South of swanns bridge on beckys Branch in Kuykendals old line, runing thence N. 80, E. 228 poles to a stake near a pine then N. 60, W. 180 poles to a Hickory near a branch, then N. 45-W 15 poles to a B. Jack in Straits land then S. 20, W. 80 poles to a red oak in place of a hickory sapling then S. 28, W. 36 poles to a maple near said bridge then S. 5, W. 36 poles, to the begining, at my death I do allow my two sons above named an equal share of the above land Divided by lot If both be living if only one be living the other is to hold said during life At one and both their Deaths I do bequeath said land to their legal heirs. If one son only should have legal heirs I allow such heire to hold all of said lands forever but if both my Sons Should have legal heirs I do allow the Land to be Divided as above and each Sons heirs to hold their fathers part of said land forever but if both these my two sons should die without such heirs as a- bpuve mentioned, At their deaths, I do Bequeath the above mention-

ed Land to my nearest heirs at law forever. And I do hereby
Constitute and appoint my trusty Brother John B. Swann Executor
of this my last will and testament. In witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand and seal the day and year above written.
