 Horse and one Set of Blacksmith tools he now works on--8th to My
 Son Joseph I will & bequeath one Horse Saddle & bridle 9th To
 My Neice Jean Sinclear I will & bequeath one Cow & Calf 10th To
 My Neice Elisabeth Herdman I will & bequeath one Cow & Calf----
