I Nancy Kimbrel of the State and
district above mention'd, do make

and publish this my last Will and Testament. And first I direct that my body be decently interred, in the burying ground of my Father (Dec'd), and that my funeral be conducted in a manner corresponding with my Estate and situation in life:

And as to such wordly estate as it hath pleased God, to intrust me with, I dispose of the same as follows. First I direct that all my debts and funeral expences be paid as soon after my decease as possible, out of the first moneys that shall come into the hands of my Executors, from any portion of my estate real or personal. I also direct that my Negroe Wench Rose and her Son John together with her future increase, be and remain loaned property to my eldest Daughter Jean Armstrong, and at her Death said property to be equally divided among said Jean's Children: Also I direct that my Negroe Wench Lyle and her son Mose together with all future increase, be and remain the loan'd property of my youngest Daughter Massy H. Hunter, and at her death to be equally divided among her children, should their be any, if not said loan'd Negroes of Mass H to be equally divided between my two Sons viz William and Rush. Also I direct that my said daughter Massy H. to have and to hold two Beds and furniture, One folding leaf Table, One Horse and Saddle One Beaurear, One Sett Table Spoons (Silver) and one Sett Tea Spoons (Silver). I will and bequeath to to my Son William I two Negroe Boys Peter and Grenn and One Wench Named July, together with the Plantation whereon I now live, also One Cupboard One Clock two Beds and furniture. I Will and bequeath to my Son Jacob Rush two Negroes Isham and Jim also one Wench named Fann, 1 Beaureau, two Beds and furniture, I direct that all my Stock of every description, together with my Waggon, and farming Utensils, also all on the plantation not herein mentioned, be sold at public Auction, and the moneys arising there-

be any balance after the discharge of said debts, I direct that the same shall be paid over to him - Ros laid out for Land for him. Also I direct that out of my Estate, two Head stones will be procured, One for my first Husband (Dr. Clawson) and the other for myself, to be of what quality my Executors may deem most proper. I do hereby make and Ordain my esteemed Neighbours William E. White, and Brother George Pettus, Executors of this my last will and Testament.
