I give to my son James one sorrel Mare, the remainder of my Cows and Calves, Two Feather beds, and furniture, one Cupboard, one folding Table, all the Kitchen Furniture, Two Chests, and all the sitting Chairs,-----

And Lastly, I do Constitue and appoint my Son James Wylie, executor of this my last will and testament-----

In Testamony whereof I have hereunto sett my hand and Seal, this Twenty first day of June in the year of our Lord one Thousand Eight Hundred and Thirty three-----
