Second I Give unto my Son Henry G. Harris a persal or part of Indian Land Runing as the Instrumt of Writing I Gave him

Third I Give and bequeath to my Daughter Polly Savill five Shillings to her and her heirs forever

Fourth I Give and bequeath to my Son John Harris one Hundred Dollors to be paid by my Exectors & c-

Fifth I Give unto my Daughter Procillah Ward one Horse kind to she and her heirs forever.

Sixth I Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Nancy Harris one Horse kind one Good bead & furnitu with all her own Bed Cloath and one Buxee and Candle Stand to she and her heirs for ever.

Seventh I Give and bequeath unto my Son Nath'l Harris the plantation I now Live on Containing one Hundred and Sixty three acres be the same more or Less Likewise all my Cattle Hogs & Sheep Waggon and gear and all my Household furniture to him his heirs forever

I likewise Constitute and appoint my Son Nath'l Harris my Executor and that the S'd Nath'l Harris Do pay all the Legases As the are given and I do hereby Disannull all and other Instrument of Writing I have unto Set my hand as this being my

Last Will and testament Whereunto I Set my hand and Seal this
