First-I will and bequeath to my beloved wife Elizabeth Thomason all my house hold furniture of Every Description Also all my Stock of Hoggs- Cattle and Sheep and Also all my horses Except the Stud Colt-which colt it is my will and desire that my Executor hereafter to be named to sell and dispose of to the best advantage by private or public sale as he may think best- and the proceeds to be applied to my just debts

Item it is my will and desire that a tract of land lyin in York District Joining lands of James Thomason Barnhill and others be sold by my Executor Either Public or Privately to the best advantage and the Proceeds of said land to be applied to my just debts and the overplush of said sale of any to be Equally divided between all my Children

Item-it is my will and desire that my wife Elizabeth Thomas live and hold possession of my home plantation her life time- and also to have and to Keep a Ngre woman Named Fanny her natural life time and at the death of my wife Elizabeth Thomason the above named Land & Negro shall be sold and Equally Divided among all my Children

Item it is my will and desire that my Children that is now living with me still remain and live with their mother as long as their Mother lives

Item -it is my will and desire that my Executor Compensate my son Lemuel Thomason for raising and gathering the Present crop now

growing on my Plantation

Item I do hereby name ordain and appoint my Son Thomas Thomasson
my Executor of this my last will and Testament in witness where-
of I have hereunto set my hand and Seal and thereby have acknowl-
ed and published this as my last will and testament Aug. 2nd 1838
