I Patrick Hamilton of the State and District aforesaid being in a low state of health but sound mind & memory do dispose of My worldly estate in Manner following (Viz)

Item First my will & desire is that all my Just debts be paid

Item Second My Will & desire is that my Negroe Woman named

Charlotte and her three Children The oldest Black Girl named fan

the two younger Mulattos Children the Girl named Rachel, the

youngest a Boy named George. I allow them to be set free as follows.

Immediately at my decease I allow Charlotte to be liberated from her Servitude.

fan I allow to be set at Liberty as

soon as she arrives to the age of Twenty one Years to be under

the care & direction of John Brown and Benjamin Chambers

The Mulatto Girl named Rachel & the young Boy George I also

wish them & it is my Will & desire that they be under the care

and direction of John Brown & Benjamin Chambers Untill they severally

arrive to the age of Twenty one Years at Which time I

allow them liberated from Servitude Georg the Young Mulatto

Boy I wish him put to some person capable to learn him the Shoe

or Boot making trade when he arrives to the age of fifteen years

Item Third I will & dispose of My Negroe Boy Richard In the following

manner I allow him Richard immediately at My decease to

be under the care & direction of John Brown & Benjamin Chambers

Lastly I Nominate & Appoint John Brown and Benjamin Chambers
Executors to this my last Will & Testament
