Lastly I do make, ordain constitute & appoint my said beloved wife Exet'x & and my son in Law Francis Carson Exor of this my last Will & Testament hereby revoking and disannuling all former Wills, Legecies, or Request by me in any wise before named Willed or Bequeathed, ratifying and Confirming this to be my last Will and Testament-
