pay the girls for the plantation on which he now lives as his note  
does more fully declair, I also wish one hundred acres of my Plan-  
tation on Moresons Creek to be devideed equally my with my Sones  
Charles & John, I give my Daughter Jane's Children William &  
John an equal part with my Daughters of the ballance of my Plan-  
tation on Moriesons Creek, I give my Sone John the half of the ben-  
efit of my machine & as before exprest an equal Share with Charles  
of one hundred acres of my Plantation on Moresons Creek & I also  
give him my Sorrel Horse Figure and I wish him to be kept on  
the Plantation for the use of the Family I give my Daughter  
Margaret & the heirs of her body my negro boy Jefferson I my  
Sorrel horse hector & also a Beanrow which is Cald her owne, I  
also give her an equal part with my other Daughters Sarah Pris-  
cilla Elizabeth & Hariet of the price of the Plantation on which  
my Sone Charles now lives as his note will Shew, I also give her  
an equal Share with my other Daughters of the ballance of my  
Plantation on Moresons Creek, I give my Daughter Sarah & the  
heirs of her body My negro woman Sinty & an equal Share with  
my Daughters Margaret Priscilla Elizabeth and Hariet of the  
price of the Plantation on which Charles now Lives, I also give  
her an equal share with my other Daughter of the ballance of my  
Plantation on Moresons Creek, I give my Daughter Priscilla & the  
heirs of her body my Negro Woman Silvy & if circumstances may

seen to require it, I, leave it discretion with my Executors to  
Sell or Swap her to the best advantage for Priscilla, I also give  
her an equal share with my daughter Margaret Sarah Elizebath &  
Harriet of the price of the plantation on which Charles now lives  
I also give her an equal Share with my other Daughters of the  
Ballance of my Plantation on Moresons Creek I also give her my  
young Colt. I give my Daughter Elizebath & the heirs of her body  
My Negro boy Dick I also give her and equal Share with my other  
Daughters Margaret Sarah Priscilla & Harriet of the Price of the  
Plantation whareon Charles now Lives, I also give her and equal  
Share with my other Daughters of the ballance of my Plantation  
on Moresons Creek I give my Daughter Harriet & the heirs of her  
body My negro Ben & also an Negro girl Lissey which Said girl I  
have bought with the four hundred Dollars Left to Harriot by her  
Fathers will I also give her an equal Share with my Daughters  
Margaret Sarah Priscilla & Elizebath of the price of the Plan-  
tation on which Charles now Live s I also give her an equal  
Share with my other Daughters of the ballance of my plantation  
on Moresons Creek I also give her my Sorrel Mare Lips & My  
Beaurow I also give her my negro woman "ancy I also allow my  
Daughter Sarah to give one hundred Dollars of the Money that is  
Due from Charles to my Daughter Priscilla, I give my Daughter  
Elizebath my half round Tables, & my Daughter Harriet my Silver  
Spoons Large and Small; and my riding chair to be kept on the  
Plantation three years for the use of the Family then to be  
Sold and the price of it to be devideed equally betweene my Daugh-  
ters Elizabeth & Harriett----

I do hereby appoint My Son John Hart and my Brother John L.  
Miller My Lawful Executors to carry the above will in to Effect  
in Witness Whareof I have hereunto Set my hand and Seal this  
Sixteenth day of September one thousand Eight hundred & twenty  
four----
