I, Robert A. Miller, Sr., formerly residing at Lowell in Gaston County, in the State of North Carolina, but at present residing in the City of Rock Hill, in York County, South Carolina, and being of sound and disposing mind and memory, but conscious of the frailty and uncertainty of human life, and desiring to dispose of the worldly goods with which my Maker has blessed me, do hereby make, publish and declare this to be my last will and testament.

First:-- I do hereby revoke and annul all wills at any time or any where heretofore made by me.

Second:-- I do hereby give and bequeath to my eldest son, R. A. Miller, Jr., the sum of One Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars, and my gold watch.

Third:-- I give, devise and bequeath to my only daughter, Annie O. Miller, my piano; and I give, devise and bequeath all my other household goods including my books, to my faithful and beloved wife Isla P. Miller.

Fourth:-- I give, devise and bequeath to my son Hugh P. Miller my five shares of bank stock, of the par value of One Hundred Dollars, in the Bank located in the town of Pineville, in Mecklenburg County, in the

Jr., the sum of One Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars, and my gold watch.

Third:-- I give, devise and bequeath to my only daughter, Annie O. Miller, my piano; and I give, devise and bequeath all my other household goods including my books, to my faithful and beloved wife Isla P. Miller.

Fourth:-- I give, devise and bequeath to my son Hugh P. Miller my five shares of bank stock, of the par value of One Hundred Dollars, in the Bank located in the town of Pineville, in Mecklenburg County, in the State of North Carolina. And I also give, devise and bequeath to my said son Hugh P. Miller seven (7) shares of stock of the par value of One hundred dollars in the Ozark Mills, located in the town of Gastonia, in Gaston County, North Carolina.

Fifth:-- I give, devise and bequeath to my only daughter Annie O. Miller my five (5) shares of stock of the par value of One Hundred Dollars, in the First National Bank of Gastonia, in Gaston County, North Carolina; and I also give, devise and bequeath to my said daughter, Annie O. Miller, my eleven (11) shares of stock of the par value of One Hundred Dollars, in the Imperial Mill, and, also one (1) share of stock of the par value of One Hundred Dollars in the Chronicle Mills, both Mills being located at Belmont, in Gaston County, North Carolina.

Sixth:-- I give, devise and bequeath to my faithful and beloved wife, Isla P. Miller, my house and lot where I am now residing one hundred and fifty by one hundred and ninety feet, more or less, situated on Park Avenue in the City of Rock Hill, in York County, South Carolina, for and during the period of her natural life, and at her death, I give, devise and bequeath said House and lot to my daughter Annie O. Miller; and in case my said daughter Annie O. Miller should predecease my wife, without leaving bodily heirs, then and in that event I bequeath said house and lot, upon the death of my said wife, to my son Hugh Parks Miller.

Seventh:-- I give, devise and bequeath to my faithful and beloved wife, Isla P. Miller, my Millen Tract of land containing One Hundred and one half (100-1/2) Acres, more or less, situated near Ebenezer Presbyterian Church, in York County, South Carolina, for and during the period of her natural life, and, at her death I give, devise and bequeath said plantation of land to my daughter Annie O. Miller; and should my said daughter Annie O. Miller die without heirs of her body, then I bequeath said plantation to my son Hugh Parks Miller.

Eighth:-- I do hereby give, devise and bequeath my plantation or tract of land in York County, South Carolina, known as the Campbell Place and containing Two Hundred and Forty Nine and nine-tenths (249-9/10) acres, more or less, to my daughter Annie O. Miller and to my son Hugh Parks Miller, share and share alike.

Ninth:-- I do hereby give, devise and bequeath to my daughter Annie O. Miller

Two Hundred and Twenty Nine and nine-tenths (~~239~~-9/10) acres, more or less, to my daughter Annie O. Miller and to my son Hugh Parks Miller, share and share alike. Ninth:-- I do hereby give, devise and bequeath to my daughter Annie O. Miller and to my son Hugh Parks Miller my two (2) tracts of land in Gaston County, North Carolina, known as the Gooch and Rankin tracts, both joining and forming one tract, of about Eighty eight (88) acres, in the following proportions, to-wit: To my daughter Annie O. Miller three fifths of said land, and, to my son Hugh Parks Miller the remaining two-fifths (2-5) thereof.

Tenth:-- All the rest, residue and remainder of my property, both real, personal and mixed, not hereinbefore specifically disposed of, I give, devise and bequeath to my faithful and beloved wife Isla P. Miller, to my son Hugh Parks Miller, and to my daughter Annie O. Miller, share and share alike.

Eleventh:-- I do hereby name, constitute and appoint my faithful and beloved wife Isla P. Miller, and my son Hugh Parks Miller, to be the Executors of this my last Will and Testament, the same to serve without bond.
