~~Robert Allison~~ of the District of York & State of South Carolina Being Considerably advanced in years but of Sound mind & disposing memory Blessed be god for the same do make this my Last Will & Testament in the manner following viz

First I Recommend my Soul into the hands of Almighty God who gave it & my Body to be decently buried at the Descretion of my Executors hereafter to be mentioned & with Regard to such worldly estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me I Bequeath Devise & dispose of in the following manner after the payment of all my just debts which I allow to be paid out of my movable property. I Give & Bequeath to my beloved wife Sarah During her Natural life the plantation whereon I live with all my personal Estate consisting of Negroes, Stovk, waggon Still & farming utensels household furniture etc. after her Decease I Bequeath to my son Robert the aforesaid plantation. I also Bequeath to my two Sons Hugh & Robert all the Negroes that may be then living be be Equally divide between them, if they should not agree themselves it is my will that they shall choose two or more disinterested persons who shall divided them according to their value. It is also mywill the necessary comforts of life and I allow him the one half of the profits arising from the farm & his mother the other half. Each paying an equal part of all Expences. Should it not be convenient for him to live with her it is my request that he should provide some suitable person to superentend the Buisness of the farm in his absence. I Reserve of the aforesaid plantation about one hundred acres ore or less as will be hereafter mentioned. I also Give to my son Robert at his Mothers Decease All the household furniture Stovk Waggon

still etc. Excepting one bed & furniture case of Drawers & wearing apparel which I allow my wife to dispose of as she may think proper, Also Excepting what may be necessary to sell for the payment of my debts & other necessary Expences. I also give and Bequeath to my Daughter Martha Cain one hundred Dollars which I allow my son Robert to pay her out of his part. Also a Negro Girl named Amy which she got when she was married the money to be paid at my wifes Decease-- I also Give & bequeath to my Daughter Margaret Henry one hundred & forty Acres of Land on the waters of clarks fork of Bullocks creek adjoining lands of Jas. Crawford & Hugh Finch--Also a Negro Boy named Les which I let her have when she was married. I also Give and Bequeath to my Daughter Catharine Henry a tract of Land being a part of my aforesaid plantation, Beginning at a corner of Samuel Lassleys land the first of second corner from a Sassafra corner in my field & Running to Malcolm Henrys spring branch and running with said branch one hundred yards thence to the mouth of Isaac Hopes Spring Branch thence up sd branch to a Beech corner standing on a bluff on which is cut the two first letters of my name. thence a northeast course untill it stricks Lassleys line thence with sd Land to the beginning supposed to contain one hundred acres more or less. Also a Negro Girl named Cynthia during my Daughters life time after her decease to decend to the Legitimate heirs of her Body with any issue of sd Girl might have. I also Give and bequeath to my two grandSons Albert & Thos. H. Allison the Sons of Thos. Allison Decd a Tract of Land lying on the waters of Bullocks creek. Beginning at a Beech Corner on Hopes spring branch & running up said branch to a field thence from the north west corner of the sd field to the ridge road Thence with said road to Lassleys line. Thence with said Land to the rocky branch. Thence with Catharine Henrys line to the Beginning. It is my will that the profits of the saw mill be equally divided between my two sons Hugh & Robert each bearing an equal

proportion of the expence. I also Reserve for the use of the saw
all the Timber that is suitable for sawing on the Tracts of land
here. to Catharine & my Grand children I also Bequeath to my three
daughters Mary A Allison Eliza & Carolina Allison being
daughters of Thos. Allison Decd. one hundred Dollars to be let
to interest & be equally divided among them when they become of
age each of my sons paying an equal part of it. I also Allow my
son Robert to Give each of my three Grand sons which was named for
me to wit Robt A Cain. Robt A Henry & Robert Allison Each a pocket-
table. I also name & Ordain and appoint my two Sons Hugh &
Robert Executors to this my last will & Testament hereby Revoking
& Disannulling all former Wills bequests & legacies made done &
appointed by me in any wise before this.
ratifying this & no other to be my last will & testament. In wit-
ness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 1th Day of
June 1827
