lawfull Debts be paid with my funeral Charges I also Will that
my Beloved Wife Margret Bozewell have her living duri her
Natural life out of my Estate & Desently Buried & funeral
Charges paid I also Give Devise & Bequeth unto my Nephew
Robert Wilson which I have raised from A Child six Negroes one
Negro Woman Named Such one Girl Named Merrak one Girl named
Elvy on Girl named Isabel one Girl named Vilot one Girl named
Harrot With my plantation that I now live on Containing one
Hundred Acres More or less with all my Houshold Furniture & Kit-
chen Furniture & farming tools with all My horses Cows hogs
& Sheep--

Also I Do Constitute & appoint My Nephew Robert Wilson And
Thomas Gibson Executors of this my last will & Testament in
Witness wharof I have harunto Set my hand and Affixed my Seal
this Twenty third Day of May 1820
