In the name of God amain this forth day of August 1825 I Robert Grere of York Destrict State of South Carolina being varey Sick and ~~now in bodey~~ but of perfict mind and memorey thanks beto God therefore Calling to mind the mortalety of my bodey and knowing that ^{it} is apointed for all men once to die due make and ordain this my last will and testament that is to Say principally and first of all I gave and recomand my Soul unto the hands of Almighty God that gave it and my bodey I recommend to the Earth to be buried in a decent ^a Cristan manor at the discretion of my Executors nothing douting but at the genrral resurection I shall recive the Saime again by the mighty pawer of God and as turning Such wourldly Estates wherewith it hath plesed God to bless me within this life I gave and dispose of the fllowing manner and forme-----

1st I gave and bequeath to my well beloved wife two nagro weomen Milley and Lucey and my gray mair and all my Stock of Cattel and all my Stock of Hoags and all my household furniture and all my citchen furniture and all my upper plantation where I now live this for to be in lue of dower and my will is that at the day of my well beloved wifes death or mariage is that this propertey for to be Equieley devided amongst my Children-----

Item 2d I gave and bequeath to my Sone William T Grere two nagro boys James and Issick and a Horse and Sadel worth one hundred and ten dollars when of age-----

Item 3d I gave and bequeath to my daughter Polley Malise one nagro girl named Jane one beade and furniture and one Sorl Colt Sucking my gray mair and Sadel worth fifteen dollars----

Item 4 I gave and bequath to my daughter Aney Nirsisa one negro girl named hannah one beade and furniture and one horse and Sad-

el worth one hundred and ten dollars when of Eage

Item 5th I gave and bequeath to my daughter Rebecka Clarecy one negro girl named Tildey one bead and furniture and one horse and Sadel worth one hundred and ten dollars when of Eage

Item 6st I gave and bequeath to my daughter Cathrin Millindy one negro girl named Margrat one bead and furniture and one horse and Sadel with one hundred and ten dollars when of eage

Item 7th I gave and bequeath to my Sone John E Grere one negro boy named Washangon one Horse and Sadel worth one hundred and ten dollars when he Comes of Eage -

Item 8th I gave and bequeath to my Sone Joseph R Grere one negro boy named richard and one Horse and Sadel worth one hundred and ten dollars when he Comes of Eage-----

Item 9th I gave and bequeath to my daughter Emley Alminah one negro girle Child the first girle Child that lives for to be Baight years oald of Milley or Lucey that I left to my wife and one beade and furnitture one horse and Sadel worth one hundred and ten dollars when of Eage-----

my will is that my lower pleantation on the Crick that it be rented out till my youngist Sone Comes of Eage and then for to be Equiley Devided betwen my three Sones William John and Joseph and at the day of my wife death or mariage my will is that my upper plantation for to be Equiley devided betwen my three Sones William John and Joseph and my will is for my nagroes Jacob and Pctor and all above mantioned to my Children for to be highered out yearly till the Come of Eage and all the rest of my property for to be put to Sail but one bay Colt name tup and the money arising from Sail and the higher of the nagroes for my just dabts for to be firs paid and then the rest to be laid out for the use of my Chilring Such as my Executors Sees the Stands in need of

and the rest for to be Equley devided as the Come of Eage this

Thompson and my brother James C Robeson and my Sene John E Grere
my Sole Executors of this my last will and testament and I doe
utterly disallow revoke and disalnuil all and evorey other forme
testament will leagices and bequeaths Certifying and Conforming
this and no other to be my last will and testament in witness
whereof I have hereunto Set my hand and Seal this forth day of
August one thousand Eaight hundred twenty five Signed Sealed and
deleavord by the S'd Robert Grere as his last will and testament
