In the name of God Amen I Robert of the District of York and state of South Carolina Planter Being in good Health and of Perfect Memory thanks be given unto Almighty God Calling to mind the Mortality of my Body and knowing that it is appointed of all men once to die do make and ordain this my last will and testament that is to say Principally and first of All I give and Recommend My Soul unto the hand of Almighty God that Give it and my body I recommend to the Earth to be buried in Decent Christian Burial and as touching such Worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me in this life I give Demise and Dispose of the same in the Following maner and form First I give and bequeth to Polley Pursley my Dearly Beloved wife the Dwelling house I now live in and All the other Buildings on the premices With all the land south of the Road leading to Henry Rites teahing My other field North of Rites in it Begins where the Road Crosses P McCarters line Beyond My Barn and Runs as before Mentioned I will and Bequeth My Beloved Wife one Horse and saddle and Bridle and too, Cows and Calves All my sheep and Hogs Also I bequeth unto My Beloved Wife All the Farming utensials and All the grain in the ground or Gathered of the Ground and the Half of the Household and Chiocken Furniture I will and bequeth My Negroe Girl silvey to her in During, her, life I will & bequeth My Daughter Margret Rite Ten Dollars I will and Bequeth My son James Pursley Ten Dollars, I will and Bequeth Katron Pursley My Daughter Silvey at her Mothers Death and Her Mare and saddle at my Death and one Cow and Calf and Heffer, and loom too Beds and Furniture I will and Bequeth to My Daughter Delilah McWhorter Ten Dollars I will and Bequeth to My Daughter Polley Patrick Ten Dollars----- I will and Bequeth to my son William B. Pursley My Negroe Gruso, and the Balance of my Plantation and at his Mothers Death I will and Bequeth the hole of it To William B Pursley Too Hundred, 50,

Acres More or less of land and lastly I do order all My un-
wild Property To be sold to Pay all my lawfull, Debts and
Funeral Expenses By My Exacitors,*****

And further I do Constitute make and ordain my Son James Pursley
and James Faulkner My Executrix and Executor of this My last Will
and Testament and I do ratify and Confirm this and no other to
be my last Will and Testament in witness Whereof I have herunto
set my hand and seal this First Day of December in the year of
our lord one Thousand Eight Hundred and Thirty five Signed Sealed
Published Pronounced and Declared by the said Robert Pursley as
his last Will and Testament in the presents of us Who in his pre-
sents and in the presents of each other have hereto Subscribed our
names--
