sum of two Dollars and to Elisabeth Criswell the sum of two Dollars
and also I Leave to my son William turner the sum of two Dollars
and I also Leave to my daughter Sarah henderson the sum of two Dol-
lars and to Ann Cambel the sum of two Dollars and it is my will that
my Son-George pay all my Just Debts and funeral expences-- and I
do Dis annul all other wills and Testaments and I Do Nominate this
to be my Last Will and testament in witness whereof I have set my
hand and Seal the day and year above Written Signed and Sealed in
the presence of us
