cel of Land lying in the barrens and also I Leave to my son John  
turner the sum of two Dollars and to my son Christopher turner the  
sum of two Dollars and to Elisabeth Criswell the sum of two Dollars  
and also I Leave to my son William turner the sum of two Dollars  
and i also Leave to my daughter Sarah henderson the sum of two Dol-  
lars and to Ann Cambel the sum of two Dollars and it is my will that  
my Son George pay all my Just Debts and funeral expences-- and I  
do Dis nnul all other wills and Testaments and I Do Nominate this  
to be my Last Will and testament in witness whereof I have set my  
hand and Seal the day and year above Written Signed and Sealed in  
the presence of us
