 markations as they can agree or if they cannot agree in the de-  
 vision, they may sell the whole and equally devide the proceeds  
 and I hereby give them a full power and right to sell and con-  
 vey to any person that may choose to purchase, and if either  
 the aforesaid James D or William should die without issue  
 then in that case I devise the share of the deceased to my son  
 Andrew L. Barry in full as was his deceased Brother to their  
 heirs forever Again in as much as my son James D has the name  
 of a cetain white horse which he claims as his own which is  
 among my Stock of horses which right I own to be Just, I there-  
 fore to make my son William equal I give and bequeathe to him  
 the s'd William my bauld horse that is now in my possession to  
 him and his heirs forever I give also to my son Andrew S. Barry  
 A bauld two year old Colt with white legs and also a new saddle  
 which must be bought with my estate to him and his heirs forever,  
 And all the rest of my estate of what nature or quality soever  
 it may be not herein before perticularly disposed of & desire
