I Rosy Hannah possessing usual health and sound mind and memory: but reflecting on the mortality of human beings do make this my last will and testament in the following manner. Item 1st I bequeath my soul to its great origin and my Body to its kindred dust at the discretion of my Executors. Item 2nd My Negro Boy Minor I give to my Brother Archibald to continue on the place for the use of the family now living together to wit Jane Ann Margaret Sarah but if either of my before named sisters or all of them should marry or by any means quit the family then Archibald is to pay each of them so quitting the family one fifth part of the value of sd Negros and have the negros to his use forever

Item 3rd My Interest in the land and premises whereon we now live I give to my before named Brother and sisters while they er any two of them may live single on ad premises in a family connection together but if such family should become extinguished by death marriage or any other means then the above bequest of Land to go to the use of my Brother Archibald his heirs and Assigns forever

Item 4th To the above Brother and sisters I lend my Bay Horse while they or any two of them lives in a family together at the dissolution of such family I give and bequeath the same to my sister Sarah forever

Item 5th To my sister Sarah & give and bequeath my Bureau and one bed to her use forever

Item 6th My bed furniture of every discription I give and be-

bequeath to my four Sisters to be equally divided amongst them. Item 7th To my brothers James Hannah and William Hannah

I give five shillings each

8th And last I hereby constitute and appoint my Brother
