and District aforesaid Deceased declared by him by word of
mouth the 22nd day of July in the year of our Lord one thou-
sand eight hundred and twenty five

1st. My desire is that my daughter Mary Barry shall have my
negroe boy Jesse which I consider she is intitled to for
her services as she is my eldest child and has been a good
girl and always with me and as to the little black horse he is
her own given to her by her brother Samuel-----

2nd And the balance of my property I wish to be sold and equal-
ly divided amongst my children (or heirs or something to that
amount) Those were the words spoken by the deceased Samuel

Barry in the presence of us (after being called upon by the
deceased) who have hereunto subscribed our names or witnesses
thereof this twenty fifth day of July in the year of our Lord
1825
