Buchanan have and possess one Mare and four head of Cattle one
bed and furntiture which she at this time claims-fifth- It is my will that my well Beloved Wife Barbara do have
the free and fulluse of all the Stock of every kind houshold
furniture, kitchen furniture and farming Utensils and implements
of husbandry, (which are not mentioned above) during her natural life, and at her death all and every part of my estate not
herein before disposed of I allow to be equally divided between
my Children William Buchanan, and Margaret Buchanapioneers.net

seventh-It is my will that whereas my son John Buchanan is dead and has left a widow and two children that the said widow of my son James and said Children be paid five Shillings each-eighth-And I do hereby constitute and appoint my well beloved wife Barbara Buchanan and my well beloved son William Buchanan Executors of this my last will and Testament --Signed Sealed and acknowledged in the presence ofus Jno Bates Sen'r.
