Chambers all of my estate both real and personal in such portions
as they will be respectively antitled to under the Statute of
distribution of South Carolina namely one third to my said wife
and the balance in equal portions to my children to them and
their heirs forever. And I do furthermore desire that my Execu-
trix and Executors shall whenever they may think it most advis-
able shall proceed to divide and distribute my said estate both
real and personal as above directed. And lastly I do hereby
nominate constitute and appoint my beloved wife Elizabeth L.
Chambers and my friends Benjamin Chambers and my oldest Son
Ellison Chambers when he comes of age and also my Son Samuel

when he comes of age Executrix and Executors of this my last will and testament. And hereby revoking all other wills and testament by me heretofore made. I do proclaim this to be my last will and testament. And Whereas I have above desired my Executrix and Executors at a such time as they may think proper to divide and distribute the whole of my estate real and personal in such portions between my wife and children, as they will be respectively entitled to under the Statute of Distribution I do hereby also desire that they may at any time until the youngest child shall become of age sell all or any of my Estate real and personal of land or the other property should in the mean time arise in value, and if they in their discretion should do so that the money arising from such sale after deducting what may be necessary for the support of the family that the balance should put out upon interest untill such time as it may become necessary to make a final distribution of my estate, And I do further will that when my Executrix and Executors shall sell off any or all of my land that they shall execute titles for the same.
