Margret Hemphill I do allow & will her to be paid fifty dollars  
as to all My Stock of horses--Cows Sheep Hogs--Farming Utensils  
Household furniture &c I allow & Will to my Son David by his  
paying the sum of three dollars to each of the rest of My  
Children--viz-- Isababeth Graham Martha Tatton--Robert Hemphill--  
Samuel Hemphill and William Hemphill--And I do hereby will  
and allow and appoint my beloved wife Sarah Hemphill and my  
son David executors of this My Last will and testament--Given  
under my hand and Seal this the twenty seventh day of Decem  
ber eighteen hundred & Twenty--
