

I, Samuel Hutchison of the State of South Carolina, and District of York, in view of the uncertainty of life, have thought proper to execute my last will and testament, and to dispose of my real and personal possessions in the following manner: namely,

I give to my son James P. a young girl named Jinsey, about fourteen years of age, a sorrel colt about two years old, a bed and furniture, a harrow, plow and harness, and one half of the plantation on which I now reside, which half shall include all the buildings now on the premises.--I give to my son Samuel B. the half of the plantation on which I now reside; but if James P. and Samuel B. or their legal representatives, cannot agree in the division of the land, it is my wish, that it be sold and the proceeds equally divided between James P. and Samuel B.

I give to my daughter Rhoda one hundred dollars; and unto my daughter Polly one hundred dollars; and unto my daughter Margaret C. one hundred dollars; and unto my son John one hundred dollars; and unto my grand daughter Isabelle Kirkpatrick fifty dollars; and unto my grand son John L. Thompson twenty dollars, which last sum is to be kept at interest by my executor until the said John L. comes of age, and then delivered to him.

It is my wish that the balance of my property be sold, and, after all my just debts are paid, that, if any balance of money remain, it be equally divided amongst my children, that are hereafter named--namely, Rhoda, Polly, Margaret C. John, Samuel B and James P. I also give to my son James P. all my house hold and kitchen furniture; and I enjoin it upon him to take good care of my old female servant Lizar during her life.

I appoint my brother, David Hutchison, my sole Executor of this my last will and testament.

I revoke all my former wills, and and declare this to be my last will and testament.
