I, Samuel Lowry of the district and State aforesaid do make ordain and declare this instrument my last will and testament
Imprimis, All my debts of which there are but few, be speedily Paid off and the legacies hereinafter bequeathed are to be discharged as soon as circumstances will permit and in the manner directed

Item. I give to my wife Susan Lowry during her Natural life or widowhood that part of my plantation whereon I now live Known by the name of the McWhorter tract together with all its improvement But should she cease to be my widow either by death or marriage whichever Shall first happen the said part of my Plantation Shall be disposed of as the ballance of my real Estate is hereafter disposed of, I also give my wife at her death to and the heirs of her body forever Eight negroes, named as follows Amy SallyLancaster, Delpha, Jose Edmond, Chany, & Dick they being the negroes She inherited of her father, I also give her four horses a choice of my Stock, one third part of my cattle & hogs, and half of my Sheep one third of my farming utensils one third of all the grain crop and one fourth of the cotton raised and made on my plantation the year of my death. My pigs & harness one waggon and gear all my household and kitchen furniture, the furniture I engaine on her to divide equally between herself and my daughters as they marry or arrive at the age of twenty one years.

Item.. All the ballance of my property not above disposed of to

placed in the hands of my Executors hereinafter named and by them
to be disposed of in the following manner (Viz.) all my negroes
not above named to be Kept together on such part of my land not
above disposed of as my Executors may think proper to Quarter them
one for the purpose of working my land provided however that if
my executors should think it best for the interest of the Estate
they may hire such as can be hired to advantage

Item It is my will that all my Lands except the McWhorter tract
disposed of above do remain undivided and be worked by my negroes
at the discretion of my executors untill my youngest child arrives
at full age and then to be equally divided between all my children
unless my Son Samuel Should wish to Settle on a part of it
when or after he arrives at full age, in that case I leave it to
the discretion of my executors whether they let him have a part
of the Said Land at a fair Valuation or not.

Item. It is my express will and wish that my Son John do Continue
at School untill he attains the age of twenty one years and
then to receive from my executors one seventh part of all my per-
sonal Estate not before disposed of subject however to a deduct-
ion of all the moneys hereafter expended for his Schooling
boarding and clotheing.

Item. I do will and bequeath my Sons Samuel, James, and William,
each one seventh part of my Personal estate, not above willed
when they arrive at the age of twenty one years, but if either of
my sons Should die before they attain that age without issue of
their body the Estate to be equally divided then between my sur-
viving children

Item In consequence of an intimation to my Son Sam'l, that I
would give him a negro boy called Little Joe I do will and bequeath
to my Said Son Samuel ~~one negro boy to be divided among the other children~~ Little Joe Exclusive of

remain in the common stock till Samuel attains the age of twenty one years.

Item I will and bequeath to my three daughters (Viz) Mary Susan & Minerva, each one seventh part of my Personal Estate when they arrive at the age of twenty-one years or marry a man of full age but if either of them should die before they arrive at that age without issue of their body then and in that case their share to be equally divided between all my surviving children

Item It is my express desire that my five youngest children do have a good English education and to be paid for by my executors out of the moneys arising from the proceeds of my farm or any other source connected with it.

Item My house and lot in the Village of York I direct my executors to rent annually and the moneys arising therefrom to be put at Interest for the purpose of Division among my heirs. Unless either of my Sons John or Samuel Should when they arrive at the age of twenty one years wish to take it at a fair Valuation in part of their share of the estate--then my executors are authorized to let either of them have it.

Item All my Stock of every description farming utensils waggon gears and Smith tools except such as were before disposed of to be moved to that part of my plantation on which the negroes are to be Quartered and Kept together on the plantation for the support of my negroes & farm unless in the opinion of my executors there should be a Surplus --then that Surplus to be Sold by them together with my Stud Horse and Sulky

Item, All the moneys arising from the sales of my property, the products of the farm or from any other source connected with them My Notes and Cash on hand I direct to be put at interest for the

purposes of Clothing educating and division amongst my children
Item. I do authorize my executors to build or cause to be built
on such part of my plantation as they may think proper comfort-
able houses for my negroes together with other Suitable buildin
for carrying on the business of the farm and preserving the crop
when gathered

Item It is will and desire that when my oldest living child ar-
rives at the age of twenty one years he or She Shall Choose one
man known for his good Sense and probity, and my executors anot
which two when chosen Shall proceed to make an estimate of all
personal property not before willed, and Select therefrom one
Seventh part for such legatee arriving at full age, which estima
and selection shall be final and conclusive as if it were my
own act and deed. The Estimate and division to be made with a
view to the interest of the whole estate

The above rule of Estimation and division to be obseved as each
of my children arrive at the age of twenty one years but no one
to receive more when he or she She arrives at age than was Sele
cted for the eldest legatee at the first division except Sam'l who
is to receive Little Joe

Lastly I constitute and appoint Minor Sadler and Andrew M. Hann
Executor of this my last Will & Testament.
