Principally and first of all, I Will and Allow all my Lawful Debts to be Paid and Funeral Charges out of my Plantation Lying in North Carolina Ruth-erford County.---Secondly I will and Bequeath to my Bloved Wife Jane the Plantation I now live on together with all my Stock Household Furniture and Farming Utensils etc., that is as long as She Remains a Widdow but if She Should Marry then my Desire and will is She Shall have one Bed and Furniture and at my wife's Death then the Property to be Divided Equally among my Children and if any of them Should go away and leave their Mother before they come of Age then my Will is that they Shall have only half a Share of What the Others Shall have--And lastly I make Consti-tute and Ordain--John McCord Francis J Nichols and my Wife to be the Executors of this my last Will and Testament. in Witness Where of I the Said Sam'l Miller to this my last Will and Testament Set my hand and Seal the Date above Signed Sealed and Delivered by the Testator as and for his last Will and Testament in the pres-ence of is--Who were Present at the Signing and Sealing thereof
