In the name of God Amen I Sarah White of York District State of South Carolina being of sound and disposing memory and calling to mind the uncertainty of my life, and being desirous to dispose of all such worldly estate as it has pleased God to bless me with, I do make and ordain this my last Will, in manner following: I allow all my just debts and funeral expences to be first paid out of my property; I will and bequeath unto my well beloved nephew Valdacon Norris Garrison and his bodily heirs all my Monies, Notes, bonds, accounts or Legacies which are or may be due to me together with two featherbeds and all the bed cloathes belonging to them two bedsteads and two underbeds also one trunk and one pine painted chest with their contents together Will all my stockings, I also will my wearing apparel to the s'd V. N. Garrison to dispose of them as he may think proper. It is my will that my neice Sarah W. Garrison have my Bureap, Saddle and bridle; And lastly, I do constitute and appoint my beloved nephew V. N. Garrison my sole executor-- to execute this my last will and testament, and I do utterly make null and void all other wills or testaments by me heretofore made or by any other person or persons made in my name and I do hereby declare and pronounce this to be my last will and testament In testimony of which I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this twelvth day of October A. D. 1833
