 ecutors to pay all my debts and with the balance of the money to
 purchase some plantation or tract of land which may be suitable
 for the family.

Item. I will bequeath and devise to my beloved wife Nancy Hill
 all my personal estate of every description whatsoever (except
 as hereafter excepted) and do also devise unto her and heirs for-
 ever the said tract of land which shall be purchased as aforesaid
 by my executors and my executors are hereby directed to execute a
 conveyance of title to her for the same and to do all other acts
 which may be necessary to secure the complete and absolute right
 thereto-unto her-

Item. It is my will and desire that my son Albert Potts Hill
 shall receive a classical and college education and for that
 purpose I hereby direct my executors to retain out of my estate
 sufficient funds to be applied for his education in such manner
 as they may deem proper.

I do hereby nominate and appoint my wife Nancy Hill and my son
W. R. Hill Executris and executor of this my last will and test-
