In the name of God Amen Thomas Barron of the state and aforesaid and in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty two being in health and of propper mind & memory do make this my last will and first my soul I recommend to God who gave it and my body decently laid in the ground Secondly all my lawful debts to be paid and Thirdly my wife Elizabeth & sufficient & comfortable support during her life or widowhood of any part of my Land That Land on which Samuel has to the South Side of the road leading Straight to my brother William's for him to enjoy but the right of it I leave to his heirs Samuel Barron in consideration of his trade to pay each of his sisters fifty dollars the remaining part of my Land to a for my other four cons the dividing line to Start at the mouth of the second draft below the ford on Kenans line and up the draft to the line next Joseph Lowry each of my boys havig an equal share by giving to each of their sisters one hundred dollars of the galue thereof in horse and saddle. The remaining part of my property to be equally divided between them all including Elizabeth my wife This I wish to be done by three men which - choose as my executors Whose names is as follows John Berry son of Roger John Howard and David Watson this I sign as my last in the presence of these
