my two Sons James Davis and Josiah Davis equally to be divided be-
tween them according to Quantity and Quality. My Son James Davis
to have the first Choice.,

3rd. I will and bequeath to my Son David Davis one heifer calf.

4th/ I will and bequeath to My Daughter Anny Patrick one heifer calf

5th. I will and bequeath all and singular the remainder of My
Personal Property to be equally Divided, after paying all my Law-
ful Debts, between My Single or unmarried Children

6th. And I do hereby naminat and appoint My My Sons David Davis
and James Davis to be the Executors of this My last will and Testa-
ment November 4th, 1821
