 immediately conveyed to my daughters Elisabethe Anne and Martha each one Hundred acres more or less) my meaning is that she shall have the whole of the Balance of my Land to her her heirs and assigns Forever also my Negro man Named Sillick I Give to her Also I Give to my wife the whole of my personals property consisting of Hogs cows Horses Sheep and also Household Furniture Kitchen utensils Farming and plantation Tools in short the whole of the Real and person property I Now possess in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this twenty Fifth Day of February In the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and twenty and in the Forty Fourth year of American Independence
