I also desire that my beloved wife shall have her living and support on my plantation during her natural life. I also order that none of my property be sold on my decease.

I also constitute and appoint my dear wife Martha and my friend I. R. McElwee as executors of this my last will and testament, In testimony of which I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this fifth day of October 1837
