I Thomas Wilson being weak in body but of sound memory blessed be God I do this first day of December and in the Year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and thirty Seven make and publish this my last will and Testament in the manner following that is to say first I give to my Brother William Wilson all that land or tenement Situate in South Carolina York District Whereon I now live believing the same to be ^{five} Two Hundred and Fifty Acres with it Several Courses and Boundaries Also I Give to my Brother, William Wilson, A Negro man named Allison, Also a Negro Boy Named Daniel Also a Negro Boy named Amzi. Also a Negro Girl Named Nancy, Also a Negro Girl named Rachel I Give and Bequeath these Five Negroes by name to my Brother William Wilson Also all my Money and notes after my Lawful debts is paid also all my Household and Kitchen Furniture to my Brother William and all my Horses and my Cattle and Hogs. Also all my Farming tools to William Wilson also I Give to my Brother, John Wilson, Five Shillings Sterling but all the remainder in this will to my Brother William Wilson But if my Brother Williams Death should happen before this Property comes to his hand then this Property is to be sold and the money Arising from the Sale of this Property to go to William Wilson Children to James. and Thomas. Wilson and Sarah Far. and Jane. Gurden and my Saddle to Jane. And I make and Ordain Capt. William Nelson and Capt. John Brown my Sole Executors of this my will in Trust in

last Will and Testament set my hand and seal, the day and Year
Above written signed sealed and Delivered by the Said Thomas
Wilson and as for his last Will in the Presence of us.
