2nd To my Daughter Mary Alexander I give & bequeath my Bed & Bedding

3rd My waring apparel I give & bequeath to my Daughters Susannah Boins & Mary Alexander to be equally divided between them

4th To my grand Daughter Eliza Daughter of Mary Alexander I give & bequeath one cow

5th The Balance of my Property together with all money due to me by note or otherwise it is my will that it be divided into three equal shares One of which equal parts I give & bequeath to my Son John Mullin. One to my daughter Mary Alexander & her children and one to my grand son James Boins son of Susannah Boins

Of this my last will & Testament I nominate & appoint William A Watson & Susannah Boins Executors In testimony of wh I hereunto set my hand & affix my seal This 27th day of November one thousand eight hundred & thirty four
