I give to my daughter Hannah, Fifty Dollars to her and her heirs forever

I give to my two daughters Sarah and Aseneth, One Dollar each.

~~I give to my Four Sons, Ebenezer, Eleazer, John, and David One Dollar each.~~

I give to my son Joel and my Four Daughters Isabella, Ixa, Anna and Kizziah all that Tract or parcel of land whereon I now live, Joining lands of William Brown, Francis Armstrong, Eleazer McCarter Samuel Wright and others, to be divided (amongst the last five mentioned children) when the youngest marries or becomes Twenty one Years of a age, to be divided by five disinterested men, the quantity to be in proportion to the quality, so that they may share and share alike to them and their living heirs of their bodys forever.

All the rest of my estate, both real and personal, of what nature or quality so ever it may be not herein before particularly disposed of, I desire may be equally divided amongst my five last children herein before named, and I give the same to them, their heirs, executors administrators and assigns forever.

And lastly, I do constitute and appoint my friends Nathaniel P. Kennedy and Alemeth Byers executors of this my last will and
