IN THE NAME OF GOD AMEN THE TWENTY EIGHTH DAY OF AUGUST 1774
I widow Enlow of the County Craven and province of South Carolina being very sick and weak in body but of perfect mind and memory thanks be given to God therfor calling to mind the mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for all men wonot to Die Dow make and ordain this my last will and testament that is principally and first of all I give and recomend my soul unto the hands of almighty God that gave it and my body I recommend to the earth to be buried in desent Christian burial at the discretion of my children and friends nothing but at the general Resurrection I shall resieve the same agane by the mighty power of God and as toching such worldly esteat wher it hath pleased God to blis me with I give demise and dispose of the same in the folloing maner and form I give and bequeath to my yonger daughter Christen Enlo all and what I have at my Death I dow herby disannull all other wills in wher unto I have set my hand and seal the daye and year above written
