 aforesaid being in a low state of health but of sound disposing
 mind and memory and remembering that it is appointed unto all
 to die, & feeling it my duty to dispose of all my real and per-
 sonal estate do make and ordain this my last will and Testa-
 ment (Viz) 1st I will that my Body be Buied in a Christian like
 manner and that all my Debts be paid 2nd I will and bequeath
 that my Negro Man Sampson be sold and the proceeds of the sale
 to be equally divided among my Eight Children viz Edmund Kendrick
 Sally Cuningham, Elizabeth Darnall Lucy Russel, William Smith,
 John R. Smith and Mary Glover, and Samuel Smith, to them & their
 heirs forever 3rd I will and bequeath to my Daughter Mary
 Glover the lot of land on which I now live containing about
 seventeen Acres - to her and her Heirs forever-----4th I will
 to my Grand Daughter Martha Jane Smith my Bed & stead & funni-
 ture-----5th the ballance of my property not enumerated in
 the above will, it is my will that it be sold and the proceeds
 if any after paying my Just debts be equally among my Eight
 Children named above-----6th & lastly I will that William Boyes
 execute this my last will and testament given under my hand and
 seal this 7th day July 1827 Signed & Sealed in presents of us
