and cupboard, her bed and furniture. Also my Punkin Mare and her

coat Also that piece of land on which Jerimiah Thomason Now

lives to be laid off as follows viz to begin where the road that

leads from samuel chambers to Ebenazar Crosseth Mr. Wright's line

thence with said road untill the road crosseth it leading to Jame

Fewels, thence with said road to where the road crosseth leading

to Jerimiah Thomasons thence running so as to include the Spring

and clear land untill it Strikes Moores line with Said line to

James Wrights line, with Said Wrights line, to the begining. 6th.

I will and bequeath to my beloved sons Wm. Ardry John Ardry & Rob

Ardry the ballance of my land equally divided amongst them Also

to my sons John & Robt Ardey I will and bequeath my Wagon and Har

ness Also in the division of the land it is to be laid off so

that Robt Ardry shall have the house in which I now live, and Joh

Ardey the place on which he now lives Also they are not to
sell trade or traffic Said land out of the family 7th. I
leave to my beloved daughters Jane Fewell and soninlaw James
Fewell my loom and tackline, also a note I have on Said James
Fewell 8th I leave to my beloved daughter Polly Thomason a
woman; Saddle or price thereof 9th I will and bequeath that
the balance of my property be Sold and equally divid betwixt
Peggy Molewaine, Betsy Priestly, Lety Alexander, Jean Fewell
and Polly Thomason, Also when divided that part which falls,
to Betsy Priestly, Lety Alexander, and Polly Thomason Shall
be for the use of these my daughters and their Heirs Lastly
I nominate and appoint Alexander Moore and Joseph McCain Exe-
cutors of this my last will & testament hereby revoking & Sit-
ting aside all former wills by me made Witness my hand and Seal
this 26th June 1829.
