York District } M. Bigger being of sound and dis-
posing mind and memory do make ordain and publish my last
will and testament. First my will is that my body be decently
buried and my just debts all paid.

Item I will and bequeath to my beloved wife Mary Bigger my
negro girl Ann and boy Allison for and during her natural life,
and allow her the possession of my dwelling house & her support
off my plantation during her widowhood, I also will and bequeath
to her and her heirs forever one bed and furniture, my chest of
drawers, two milch cows, and her choice of my horses and a saddle
and bridle.

Item I will and bequeath that all my property remain on my plan-
tation until my youngest child arrives to the age of twenty one
years (except such as heretofore bequeathed to my wife) for the
support maintenance and education of my children and then the
personal property not heretofore bequeathed to be equally divid-
ed between my wife should she remain unmarried until that time
and my three children share and share alike but should my wife
marry before that time she is to have no part thereof I also
will and bequeath that the two negroes herein bequeathed to my
wife during her natural life at her death be equally divided be-
tween my children but it is my express will and bequest that the
legal title to all the property herein allowed willed or bequeath-
ed to my two daughters do not vest in them but in my executors to
and for the use and benefit of my said daughters during their
natural lives and at their deaths to their children respectively,
living at that time forever

Item I will and bequeath to my son James Lysander Bigger all my
real estate not herein otherwise disposed of to him and his heirs
forever,

Item I hereby nominate constitute and appoint my beloved wife executrix and Doct. David Watson executor of this my last will and testament and hereby authorize and empower them should they at any time deem it advantageous to sell and dispose of any of my personal estate and vest the money in other property or put it out to interest, the profits of it to be applied to the support and education of my children until the youngest child arrives to twenty one years and then to be divided as heretofore directed.

In testimony whereof I have hereto set my hand and affixed my seal this fourteenth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty nine.
