I William Chambers of York District in the State of South Carolina being advanced in Years & much on the decline of Boddy health & Vigor but of perfectly sound mind & memory calling to mind the mortal state of man that it is appointed for all men to die & not knowing how soon my disolution by death may take place do make and constitute this my last will & Testament that is to say First. I resign my soul to God the giver & my body to be decently interred into the earth from whence it came Secondly as to my worldly property I leave & bequeath as follows after the payment of my Just debts I leave and bequeath unto my grand daughter Mary Chambers now the wife of Wm. Compton Eighty dollars to be paid unto her in one year after my death 3rd. I leave & bequeath unto my grand daughter Seena Chambers my son Davids Daughter My house Clock 4th And I will my Land all my other property unto my four children Viz. John Chambers & David Chambers Elizabeth Neely Wife to John Neely & her Children after her & Wm. Maxwell Chambers equeally be divided between them & if it should so appear that my Land cannot Satisfactorily be equeally divided between them that each can get an equal Value thereof in Land it is my Will that some one or More of them Should have the Land & pay to the others an equal amount to their devidends thereof or if none of my children will keep it & pay as aforesaid then I allow it to be sold & the amount be equeally divided between them & whereas my son Wm. Maxwell has been absent in Georgia or elsewhere I have not heard of him for a number of years if it should so be that he should be dead or could not be

found to receive his devidend in case I allow his devide equeal-
ly to be divided between my other three Children above named
5th. & whereas I have paid two debts for my son John sence he
left me Viz. one to Wm. Gilmore dec'd & one to John Latta Admr.
I allow said two debts to be counted up to my said son John in
his Right of Claim to this my last Will & I do hereby nominate
constitute & appoint John McCulloch my Sole Executor of this
my last Will & Testament hereby revokeing & makeing void all
former Wills & Testaments at any time heretofore by me Made &
do declare this to be my last Will & Testament In Witness where-
of I have Set my hand & seal this 4th December A. D. 1838
