first I Give and bequeath unto my sons Richard and William-Champion my tract of land lying on Kings creek I also Give and Bequeath unto my son John Champion four Hundred dollars to Be paid by my sons Richard and William Champion I also give and bequeath unto my sons John Richard and William Champion all my carpenter tools to be divided as they can agree Amongst themselves I also give and bequeath unto my daughters Lucretia Allen Sara Scot Faith McIntire Delilah Champion Bery Armand Fany Heflin an Equal part of my household furniture Horses Cattle Sheep and Hogs and farming utensils to be sold and Equally divided amongst them I likewise make and ordain my sons Richard and William Champion Executors of this my Last Will and testament And I do hereby Utterly disallow Revoke and disannul all and Every other former testaments Wills Legacies and Executors By me in any wise Before named Will and Bequeathed Ratifying and Confirming this to be my last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal this tenth day of february in the year of Our lord one thousand Eight hundred and sixteen
