And now haveing a Sound disposing mind.....do make Constitute and appoint this my last Will and Testament

Revokeing all others In words and form following-----

1st. I give and bequeathe unto my beloved wife Rachael Choat all my personal Estate or property Consisting of Hogs Horsees Cattle Fowls Household and Kitchen Firniture of every description together with my Intrust I hold in my Waggon and black smiths Tools I further Devise to her all my farming Tools dureing her natural life. I further Devise She Keep with her my Son Newton dureing her Natural Life-----

2ndly I give and bequeathe unto my Daughter Rachael E. Choat a respectable part of room of my house dureing her single Life. wit and Intrust in as much of my person Estate as may be thought nessary by my beloved wife Rachael Choat also I further Devise at the Death of my wife Rachael Choat all my personal Estate Except what I hereafter name to my two Sons to my daughter Rachael Choat to her and to her Heirs forever.

3rdly I give and bequeathe unto my Son Augustine D. Choat Jointly with my Son James Simeral Choat my Intrust in my Black Smith Tools and Waggon together with all my farming Utentials of every Description to them and their Heirs forever.

The above and last Devise to be in force at the Death of my Wife Rachael. I also at the Same time Devise unto the Said Agustín D. and James S. Choat the Tract of Land whereon I now

live lying on both Sides of Rocky Allison Creek to be Devided
as follows begining on a large poplar on the South west Side o
Said Creek thence to the Creek and Its Meanders down to the
mouth of Fewels Spring branch thence up the Said branch to the
first hollow thence up the hallow to the Line. This last be-
queathe to be also in force at the Death of my Wife Rachael
Choat on Condition that the Said Augustin D. Choat and James.
S. Choat Do after the Death of my wife Decently Maintain my
Son Newton dureing his natural Life and If in Case that one or
both Should make Sale of the Land then I bequeathe one fourth
of the proceeds of the Sale Money to be Deposited in Some Safe
Stock or hands to be used with discressin for his Support,
Augustin D. Cheat to have the South West Side of the Creek whar
he now lives and James S. Choat the North East Side whare I now
live to them and their Heirs forever-----

4thly It is my Desire that as much of my personal Estate or
property be sold to pay all my Just Debts and to defray all
Lawfull Expences that may occur to my Executors in Executing th
my last will and Testament-----

5thly I Nominate and appoint my beloved wife Rachael Choat Ex-
ecutrix with my Two Sons Augustin D. Choat and James S. Choat
Executors of this my last will and Teestament and that I have at
my request in the presents of each other caused the attestation
of William Anderson Caleb Gassaway & James W. Wilkerson to
Subscribe their names to this the last Solemn Act of my Life
given under my own hand and Seal This The 24th day of November
1830
