of three & seventy four acres of land which is leased to me by the
Catabaw Indians by a lease bearing Date the Eighteenth Day of
August one thousand Eight Hundred & fifteen also a negro boy
named Steven & Negroe girl named Mary

Item I give & Bequeath forever to my son William N. Dunlap one
Hundred acres of land on which He now lives and wh ch formerly
belonged to my Brother David Dunlap for which I hold Sheriff's
Titles also a negroe Boy named Toney & a negroe g rl name Salley.

Item I give & Bequeath forever to my son James Dunlap one Hund-
red acres of land Bounding on Allen I. Greens land & the land Be-
queathed to My son William, also Two negroe boys named Isen &
Allen & a negroe girl named Else

Item I give & Bequath forever to my Daughter Elizabeth Dunlap
five negroes Viz Selia Nance Henry Mose Lewis.

Item I give & Bequeath forever to Mary Dunlap & Susanah Dunlap
my son Georges two Daughters, four Hundred & fifty Acres of land
which I purchased from Thomas Gary.

Item I give & Bequeath to my two sons Williams & James above
named, to be Held by them Jointly four Hundred & Twenty seven
Acres of land leased to me by the Cataba Indians by lease bearing
Date the Eighteenth Day of August 1815.

Item I give & bequeath forever to My Wife Susanah Dunlap the
whole of My Estate Both real & Personal which has not been named
above

Lastly Do hereby appoint & ordain my said Wife Susanah Dunlap
Executrix of this my last Will & Testament.
