In the Name of God Amene, I William Galloway Cenir of York District Planter being in Resonable halth in body and of Perfect mind and memory thanks be given unto God Calling unto mind the Mortality of body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to Die do make and ordain this my last will and tastament that is to say Principaly and first of all I give and Recomend my Soul unto the hands of almighty God that give it and my body I Recomand to the earth to be buried in dacent Christen Buriel at the discretion of my Executors Nothing doubting but at the genrel Ressurrection I Shall receive the Same agane by the mighty power of God and as touching Such worldly estate wharewithe it has Pleased God to bless me in this life I give demise and dispose of the Same in the Folowing manor and form first I give and Bequath to my son James galloway one hors and two Cows and Calves and one bead and furniture one Still and two tracts of land, the one I bought from William Alexander and the other I bought from Jones Bales I also Bequathe to my daughter Margaret Dowdel the halph of that tract of land that I bought from William Wright South of the tract I kow live on, and fifty dollars, I allso Bequathe to my Son William Galloway the little Still, the land he did liveon to Stand for his Share of land, and I allso Bequathe to my doughter Mary Dowdel the other halph of that tract of land that I bought from William Wright and fifty dollars, and I allso bequeathe to my doughter Gain Galloway the tract of land that I know live on, and the tract of land Ajoining the tract I know live on that I bought from John Travice, and one Hors and Sadle and bridle, and two Cows and Calvs and one bead and furniture, All the rast of my real and Parsonal astate that Remanes is to be equally Devided to my Sons and Doughters Except to them or thair heirs the know prea-

sent Crop of the farne, it Shll Remain for the use and ban-
ifit of my Son and Daughter Jame and Gain Galloway, My son
James Galloway and John Reaney to be my Executors of this
my last will and Tastement I Do hereby uterly disalow Re-
voke and disannul all and every other form tastaments wills
legaces Bequests and Executors by me in any wise before
named willed and bequeathed Ratifying and Confirming this and
no other to be my last will and tastament in witness wharof
I have hereunto sat my hand and Seel this fifth day of Sept-
ember in the year of our Lord Eightteen hundred and twenty
six, Sined and Sealed published pronounced and declared by the
said William Galloway Cnr. as his last will and tastament in
the preasence of us who in his presence and in the presence of
Each other have hereunto Subscribed our Names

CODICIL

South Carolina } I William Galloway of said State & District
York District } having made & Executed a Last will & testa-
ment & Several years past in which a Legacy was given my daugh-
ter Gaine of my real Estate & within the boundary of which land
I have since Given a writing obligatory to Edward Feemster giv-
ing him Liberty to flood a certain spot on the southern side of
Alexandres Branch, a Small Stream running into Bulls Creek Now
I revoke so much of my will as relates to this spot of Land to
be flooded and fully Confirm my Daughter Jane in the remainder
of the bequests to which this item has reference

2nd Having in my will given my daughters Margaret and Mary be-
quests of Land I revoke those clauses in my will and give &

bequeath my son James the whole Land not left to Jame on Con-

dition that he pay Mary two hundred & fifty dollars & my daughter Margaret one hundred & twenty five dollars. In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this twenty third day of March A. D. 1837 And sixty first of American Independence.
