first I do resign my soul to God who give it

second as to my worldly estate that God has blest me with my will is that my wife Prusillar do Live on my plantation & have her Living off the same as long as she doth live and that she doth kept my Children with her and all my other property after my Just Debts be paid and as my Children grow up or marry and Leave her that she may give them such help as she is able so that what she get shall be valued that at her Death there may be an equal division made amongst them all and as for my daughter Cinthy Berry I have give her one Cow and Calf her Bed and furniture and one side saddle one sow and other things and my will is that the do be valued and an account kept that at my wifes death or when my youngest Child doth come of age that there may Be an equal Division made amongst them all also my will is that after my Decease that my property Be appraised and so much sold as will pay my Debts with what is owing t me and I also do appoint and ordain My Brother Joseph Kendrick and Joseph Mc Kenzie Esquire executors of this my Last will and testament made and signed this fourth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and twenty four
