first I Give & Bequeath my Soul to God Who give it and my Body to Be Decently Burried at the Discretion of my Executors Itam 2d if He Robert Rainey should after my deceas fail or decline to perform aney part of the Requisites mentioned in a Deed of Gift made By me to my Daughter Rosana Rainey Bearing Date the 12th Day of July one Thousand Eight hundred and twenty five then in th't case He Robert Rainey is altogether Bared from Having aney Right on Title in any wis to the Land mentioned in th't Deed of Gift made to my Daughter Rosana Rainey By me

Itam 3d if aney of My other two Sons William Or John Rainey on failure of Robert Rainey Performing the Requisites of the Deed of Gift By me made to Rosana Rainey By me I will them to enjoy the Lands mentioned in Th't Deed of Gift at the Experation of the tim th't aney or all my then Single Daughters may not Stand in Need of the occupation of sd Land with this Restriction th't my grand son Son William G. Rainey May Hold and occupy the sd Land during His natural life time also along with his aunts if he should think proper to do so--

Itam 4th if He my Son Rob't Rainey at my Deceas Do undertake to Comply with the Requisites Contained & Exhibited in the Second and third Claus or Bequest of this my last will and testament I Give & Bequeath my Negro man Jack unto him the sd Robert Rainey During

Rainey will Humanely treat the sd Negro By Keeping Him warmly
& Comfortably Clothed & feed and pay yearly & Every year to the
sd Negro Jack two Dollars for his own individual use ect
Item 5 I Give and Bequeath to my Son William Rainey my Negro
fellow April During his Natural Life time and His Heirs after
him w'th this Restriction th't is to Say He is to Be a Human
Marter to feed & Gloath warmly and Comfortably and pay two Dow-
lers to the sd Negro April yearly and Every year for His own
use Exclusive of all other Demands

Item 6th I give & Bequeath my Negro Man Named Need to my three
single Daughters to wit Rosana Lilley Ann & Rebecka Rainey Dur-
ing their Life time And at the Decease of the Longest Liver of
the three Daughters to wit Rosana Lilly Ann & Rebecka Rainey I
will th't if the sd Negro Need Be the property of Ganet innis
Kirkpaterick & hir Heirs my Grand Doughters under the same Re-
strictions to be well feed and wormly Clothed and yearly and Ev-
ery year paid two Dollars for his own use ect.

Item 7thy I also Give & Bequeath to my three single Daughters
all or sufficient Quantity of my farming utencials Sufficient
to Carry on their farm after or at my Deceas or on the first
of January 1829 with a Competent Dividend of the present Crop
Both of Cotton Corn & other provisions to suport upon untill
they Can Suport on their own Industry with my Intentions to
Settel and Deliver to Each of thes Children my all to Be Ocupi-
ed and improved By them agreeable to the Dividend and arrngment
I have Made in this my Last will and testament interlined Before
Signed I do hereby Nominate & apoint my Son John Rainey & Sam'l
Wiley my trusty friends Executors of this my Last will and test-
ament ect.
