Yogue at the Discretion of my Executor be Sold or hired & the
money arrising therefrom I will to my beloved Daughter Martha
Robinson I also will that the Remainder of my Personal property
be sold at the Discretion of my Executer & the moncys therefrom
I will to my Beloved Daughter Martha Robinson I also will that if
my Beloved Daughter Should Die without any lawful heirs that my
property Should be Equally Devided amongst Brother Robert Robinsons
family---

I do hereby nominate & appoint Samuel Given Executor of this my
last will and Testament & Declare this to be my last will & test-
ament In Witness whereof I have hereunto Set my hand and Seal
this 24th day of February in the Year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred & twenty one & in the forty fifth year of American
Independance .
