cond, I give & bequeath unto My only brother Isom G. Stanton the whole
of My land property & my Negro boy Called Cyrus, and also My two horses
& waggon--
Thirdly, I give & bequeath unto My Sister Eliza E. Stanton My Small
Negro girl Called Harriet Lastly, I leave My negro girl Selena to be
Sold for Cash either at public or private sale as My Executor shall
think proper, out of the proceeds of which together with My notes &
accounts I allow all My Just debts to be paid and the overplus if any
together with all My other property of what Kind & Nature whatsoever
not otherwise bequeathed I give & bequeath unto My brother Isom G.
Stanton;--

And I do hereby appoint My brother Isom G. Stanton Sole Executor of
this my last will & testament, hereby revoking all former wills by
me made, In witness whereof I hereunto set My Name & affix my seal,
this the 15th of March 1835
