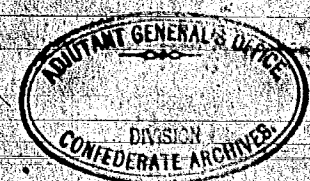

That I will not take up arms again against the United States, nor serve in any military, police,

America, until duly exchanged by the proper authorities.
