Smith's Company (1st) of the 1st Regiment of Infantry, Mass., born in Mass., 1861, in the State of Mass., 1861, years, 5 feet, 7 inches high, complexion, fair, eyes, blue, hair, black, and by profession, private, was enlisted by Capt. W. H. Smith, at Worcester, Mass., on 18th day of March, 1862, at 18 years, and is now entitled to a discharge by reason of discharge from service. The said Alfred was not paid by Paymaster from service from service to 1862. Include the 18th day of March, 1862, eighteen hundred and sixty two, and has pay due from that time to the present date to the 18th day of March, 1862.

There is due him for travelling from Worcester, Mass. to the 18th day of March, 1862, being 1 mile at 1 cent per mile, dollars on account of Clothing 1 dollar.

There is due him 1 dollar for Commutation of Horse 1 dollar, given at Worcester, Mass., 18th day of March, 1862. He is included in the Confederate Ration at Worcester, Mass., 18th day of March, 1862.

He is labelled by W. H. Smith, at Worcester, Mass., 18th day of March, 1862, as Private, 1862. Given to Duplicate at Worcester, Mass., 18th day of March, 1862. Commanding Company, 1st Regiment of Infantry, Mass.

For pay from 18th day of March, 1862, being 1 month and 18 days of 1862, at 1 dollar per month, 48 dollars.

For pay for travelling from Worcester, Mass. to the 18th day of March, 1862, being 1 mile at 1 cent per mile, 48 dollars.

For Clothing not drawn 1 dollar at 1 cent per day, 48 dollars.

For Commutation of Horse 1 dollar at 1 cent per day, 48 dollars.

Balance due 95 dollars.

Received of Alfred, 18th day of March, 1862, 1 dollar, in full of the above account, and 48 dollars, 48 dollars, 95 dollars.
