I Aber. Willans of Dallas County State of Alabama
Planter being now in Vulnerable Health and of Sound Mind
and disposing Memory do make and execute this my last
Will and Testament in the Words and Figures following to witness
First I desire that all my just debts and expenses be
paid. Second I will and bequeath to my daughter Adinda
W^e. Willans my Cabin and that house & garden there in it
and my Negro Man Austin who usually drives the carriage.
Third I set the remainder of my personal and household effects
and Rights and Credits of mine to be equally divided among my
children viz Daniel W. Willans and Lucy W. Willans
Adinda W. Willans my cousin Drayton, Sader Drayton
and Abby Jackson by Commissioner appointed by the
Orphans Court there and there about.

Fourth I will and wish all my lands situate by my Executors
at public Sale in a Term of twelve Months from this day
to be sold of time and place of Sale being first given by letter of
Testament in some newspaper published in the County and
the Proceeds to be equally divided among my children above
named. Fifth I desire of my Estate getting to my
Daughters to be for their Special and Separate use and
Benefit during their Natural lives, Cash, and Not to be
Subject to the Control or liable to the debt of their or
either of their husbands, and then to be equally divided
among the lawful heirs of their bodies, viz each daughter's
children to have their Mother's Share. And for the purpose
of carrying out my intention in this respect the Court to
appoint a Trustee for each of my said daughters who
shall in no instance the husband of either of my daughters
Sister W. M. Minot and appoint my son Drayton W. Willans
William P. Mclellan and Abner H. Lewis Executors of this my
last Will and Testament hereby revoking all other and former
Wills by me heretofore made. Attestment whereof

Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred & Forty, make
and publish this my last Will and Testament in the
following manner that is to say. First I appoint my
son John William Haskeen and Nabal Haskeen my
executors to this my Will & Testament, and second at my
death I desire to be decently buried in a Christian like
manner, and thirdly I desire that all of my just debts
and funeral expenses be paid, and fourthly I give
all my property both real & personal that is to say
of to my wife Polly Haskeen and my three daughters,
(viz) Susan Haskeen, Sarah Haskeen, and Eliza
Haskeen, and it is my wish that the property both real
& personal be kept together by my executors as the common
joint property of my wife Polly Haskeen & my three daughters
Susan, Sarah & Eliza, in equal shares in common
and at the death of my wife land it should be divided
by my daughters above named, and if dependent by my
executors then for them to divide the property equally
between my three daughters, Susan, Sarah & Eliza, for
their use & benefit. In testimony whereof I have
